Reporting Standards Goal: To provide a current “Snapshot” of grade-level standards and to communicate individual student’s progress on meeting those goals.

Standard Design: High quality standards are designed to prepare students for success in future grades, for high school readiness, for college and career readiness.



Change in Scoring: Teachers have decided to simplify scoring ratings from the fraction system (ex. 1/1, 1/3, 2/3) to a flat score of 1, 2, or 3. The common understanding of these ratings is:

3 – Proficient – “I got this!”

2 – Progressing/Developing, “I did some things right, but I’m not there yet”

1 – Beginning – “I really don’t get this yet”

N – Need additional data
